The Swedish Mathematical Society invites applications for travel scholarships from undergraduate researchers in mathematics, i.e. those who have not yet completed their doctoral degree.

The Wallenberg scholarships are intended to be used as partial financing for conference participation and shorter research visits abroad. The scholarships can be used as full or partial financing for travel costs, accommodation, conference fees etc, but not to allowance. The scholarship amount is maximum 4,000 SEK/person.

The Essén scholarships are primarily intended for participation in summer schools and similar activities. Otherwise the same rules apply as for the Wallenberg scholarships except that the scholarship amount can be a minimum of SEK 4,000 and a maximum of SEK 8,000.

The application must contain

- A short CV
- Budget for the trip
- A brief account of the significance of the trip for the applicant's research work (this must be supported by a certificate from the supervisor)

and address details (incl. e-mail address). It shall state whether the application relates to Wallenberg or Essén scholarship, or both; however, Wallenberg and Essén scholarships normally are not awarded simultaneously to the same applicant. The application must be received no later than March 31, 2024, and sent electronically (one (1) pdf file) to
